Asking a Question: Saving a Life

Sixteen Faith Partners' churches from Hickman to Raymond and all over Lincoln are hosting free, 90-minute QPR training events. These 16 churches come from 11 different denominations. Two additional trainings will be on Zoom.

What's QPR?

QPR stands for Question, Persuade and Refer—three simple steps anyone can learn to help save a life from suicide. QPR trains ordinary people to recognize the warning signs of a suicide crisis and then to question, persuade and refer that person for help. Ordinary people have used these tools to save 100's of lives.

These free 90-minute training sessions will be held throughout our community and on Zoom between September 4 and 13. Anyone can easily find a time and place that fits their schedule.
